Using a computer, create a digital drawing, select and mark off all the lines, curves and shapes you need, and paint in colors, textures and shading, and you're done. That's exactly how it works today. But, it wasn't always like this. It began with a pen that came with AutoCAD. In the late 1980s, before AutoCAD had a keyboard, computer mouse or graphics tablet (or a multi-tool that combines all three), drawing a straight line was a complicated process. The most efficient way to do it was by using the pen in AutoCAD. It was a high-tech solution that only the elite professionals were allowed to use. According to the AutoCAD history, when AutoCAD was first introduced in December 1982, users started complaining that the pen in the program was too difficult to use. The first AutoCAD customer, a 3D graphics firm, needed a solution to speed up the design process for its complex 3D data. After testing several pen/trackball solutions, they came up with a pen that features an input mechanism with a ball at the end of a three-inch lever that can be rotated 360 degrees and tilted 90 degrees. The first object users were instructed to draw was a triangle. After this, they had to start using the pen, until they were comfortable with it. The company's success with this new pen/trackball technology resulted in the development of other AutoCAD pens and trackballs to satisfy customer requirements. The first-generation pen technology became known as 'The Pen' and eventually formed the basis of the AutoCAD pen that we use today.

The History of the AutoCAD App The AutoCAD App was the first AutoCAD software product designed as a mobile app and was first released in 2013. Graphics The basic graphics program for AutoCAD is referred to as the Windows Graphics User Interface or WUI. The interface includes the Windows taskbar and

window controls. It also has the ribbon interface. However, the WUI is limited in that it only allows drawing using the type tools included in the user interface. Some users need a different tool set to create and edit drawings. This is accomplished by using other software. In addition, the WUI does not support high-resolution vector graphics, or images with transparency. Additional Windows graphics programs are: VectorWorks has a graphical interface that provides a broad range of capabilities, including enhanced drawing tools. CadSoft specializes in the development of AutoCAD plugins that can be used as third-party tools. SoGo is a CAD/BIM software application for the purpose of creating and editing product and construction documentation. Cadsoft offers a set of 3D CAD and BIM applications for the design of building and manufacturing. Another additional graphics program is VectorWorks, which provides broad capabilities. AutoCAD's ability to create high-resolution vector images, or vectors, was originally limited. In October 2011, with version 2013, AutoCAD created and uses vector images natively, without converting them to raster images. Vector images may be created in various file formats such as DXF and DWG. The feature is called Vector Graphics and is accessed from the View menu. AutoCAD also supports stereographic image (stereo) files, which are stereo images that display three dimensions. Stereo files are created from the same file as the raster image files. AutoCAD supports transparency in raster images, but cannot yet display any kind of transparency in vector images. AutoCAD has also incorporated an ability to create emails from information contained within a drawing file. The emails can be sent to a web-based email service such as Microsoft Office 365. AutoCAD is able to convert to other file formats such as JPEG
